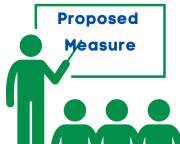


# 4 THINGS TO KNOW

## ABOUT THE PROPOSED LOCAL OPTION SCHOOL TAX



1

If passed, the Local Option School Tax would fund approximately 90 teachers in the district.

2

If passed, this measure would provide funds to maintain current programs and staffing levels at schools for 5 years.

3

If passed, this measure would authorize renewal of the current tax and would cost property owners \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. The owner of a home assessed at \$300,000 would pay \$450 per year or \$37.50 per month.

4

If the measure does not pass, the teachers and programs would not be funded as proposed and the current property tax of \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value would expire in June 2025.
