## Public Oregon Universities that specifically Support First Gen Students

- <u>University of Oregon</u>: Offers a First-Generation Community for residential students and provides resources and academic support to promote success in the college environment.
- Western Oregon University: Has received national recognition for its commitment to first-generation students and has a diverse student body that includes many first-generation individuals.
- <u>Portland State University:</u> Has a significant first-generation student population and offers various support services, including scholarships, financial coaching, mentorship, academic support, and an annual event for first-generation and diverse students called Bridges.
- Oregon State University: Celebrates first-generation students with dedicated events and provides
  programs like the Catalyst Scholars Program in the College of Engineering, which offers financial
  assistance and funding for experiential learning to students with high achievement and unmet
  financial need.

## Private Oregon Universities that specifically Support First Gen Students

- <u>Linfield University</u>: Features the First Scholars program, which supports first-generation students
  through a growing network of peer mentors and tailored programs designed to meet their unique
  needs.
- <u>University of Portland</u>: Has a First Generation (FGEN) program with dedicated community sessions
  and student ambassadors that offer guidance and foster connections for first-generation students
  and their families.
