### NEW MEMBER SELECTION FORM

National Honor Society is a membership society for juniors and seniors who exhibit high standards of *Leadership/Recognition/Awards, Service, Co-curricular and Community activities, and Character*. In order to apply, students must follow the selection process:

#### **NHS Process for New Member Selection:**

- All members must be a junior or senior.
- Join our Google Classroom using the code pp43rju
- Must have 3.5 weighted cumulative GPA through last semester, June 2022.
- Must be enrolled in at least 5 academic courses each semester.
- Behavior is in good standing.
- Attendance in good standing. Students with a “chronically absent” attendance status, meaning students that are present less than 89% of the time, may not be eligible for NHS.
- 20 hours of independent community service completed and documented by the selection deadline of **Friday, September 30**. Service hours must have been completed from October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. The form is on the website and in google classroom.
- Completion of the Selection Form and turned in by **3:30 p.m., Friday, September 30, 2022**. All Selection Forms will be screened and evaluated by faculty committee and official notification of status will be made by the October NHS meeting date.
- Once you have been officially accepted to NHS, you will need to pay the \$20 membership fee.

#### **Criteria for Selection into the West Linn High School chapter of the National Honor Society:**

**1. *Leadership/Recognition/Awards:* Leadership is leading other people while in a position of authority and responsibility. Some examples would include:**

- Coaching children in an organized sport or activity.
- Being a team captain or co-captain.
- Being a camp counselor or co-counselor.
- Leading some activity or organized function.
- Elected into a school or non-school position.

**2. *Service:* Service is donating your time and energy to the community when it is not required of**

**you. Some examples would include:**

- Helping at community or city fundraisers or specific causes.

-Volunteering at food banks, the Red Cross, etc.

-Assisting scouts, church programs, or community centers.

-Tutoring NON-family members

**3. *Co-curricular and Community activities:* Activities you have participated in during high school. These include clubs, teams, musical groups, church groups, Scouts, etc.**

**4. *Character:* Character is about ethics, honesty, and reliability. You are courteous, respectful, and show a concern for others. You uphold a high level of dependability and others see you as a person with outstanding principles.**
