National Honor Society is a membership society for juniors and seniors who exhibit high standards of *Leadership/Recognition/Awards, Service, Co-curricular and Community activities, and Character*. In order to be a continuing member, students must follow the re-selection process:

NHS Process for Returning Member Re-Selection:

- Join our Google Classroom using the code pp43rju
- Maintain 3.5 weighted cumulative GPA through last semester, June 2022
- Must be enrolled in at least 5 academic courses each semester.
- You were an NHS member in good standing during the 2021-2022 school year.
- Behavior in good standing.
- Attendance in good standing. Students with a “chronically absent” attendance status, meaning students present less than 89% of the time, may not be eligible for NHS.
- 20 hours of independent community service completed and documented by the re-selection deadline of **Friday, September 30, 2022**. Service hours must have been completed from October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. The form is on the website and in google classroom.
- Completion of the Returning Member Selection Form and turned in by **3:30 p.m., Friday, September 30, 2022**. All Returning Member Selection Forms will be screened and evaluated by a faculty committee and official notification of re-acceptance will be by mid-October.
- Once you have been officially accepted, please pay the \$20 membership fee.

Standards for Re-Selection into the West Linn High School chapter of the National Honor Society-(Returning members do not need to verify examples of these criteria again, except for service hours):

1. ***Leadership/Recognition/Awards:*** Leadership is leading other people while in a position of authority and responsibility.
2. ***Service:*** Service is donating your time and energy to the community when it is not required of you. ***Returning members must show proof of 20 service hours and documented on the NHS Service Hour form.*** Students may use 6 hours of Link Crew time, 6 hours of Unity Day time, and 6 hours of Outdoor School counseling as part of the service hours.
3. ***Co-curricular and Community activities:*** Activities you have participated in during high school. These include clubs, teams, musical groups, church groups, Scouts, etc.
4. ***Character:*** Character is about ethics, honesty, and reliability. You are courteous, respectful, and show a concern for others. You uphold a high level of dependability and others see you as a person with outstanding principles.
